Mr. Clark expressed that the EAC should limit its discussion and concerns to strictly environmental perspective. Mr. Norris offered clarification that at this time there are no submitted development plans or specifics of use or development and that the request to council is for rezoning of one of the Town Common lots to allow for commercial uses within the park in alignment with the Town Common master plan. The committee expressed concerns about loss of green space within the Town Common. Dr. Shaw and Ms. Maxwell will develop a position statement to be submitted to Mr. Norris to pass along to the City Manager and Council. Dr. Shaw recognized Mr. Shane Smith from the audience to speak about the human impact of additional uses within the Town Common.
