1. Q - Regarding rfp Debris Management and Removal Services, do you currently have a contract for these services? If so, can we get a copy of the bid tabulations?

A – The City use the local county landfill, 3025 Landfill Road Greenville, NC 27834
3. Q - When are the payment and performance bonds due?  
A – P & P bonds are not due with the proposal
4. Q - Do we need to fill out and return p.13 with the proposal submittal? Does it require a signature?  
A - No, will need to be filled out for actual contract by the selected contractor
