Title of Item: Presentation on the feasibility study prepared by Convergent Solutions

Explanation: **Abstract:** Rick Kiernan of Convergent Solutions will present the findings from the feasibility study on the creation of a united Pitt County economic development plan.

Explanation: Earlier this year, the Pitt County Committee of 100, the City of Greenville, Pitt County, and Greenville Utilities engaged Convergent Nonprofit Solutions, a nationally recognized strategic planning and fundraising firm, to guide us through the process of exploring the creation of a united Pitt County economic development plan.

In April, over 100 Pitt County public and private sector leaders participated in a series of roundtable discussions. In August, the Convergent team conducted 61 interviews with 69 business and community leaders from both the public and private sectors. Convergent is now in the process of presenting their findings to the boards of the four entities engaged in the study.
