The Recreation and Parks Department is pleased to invite the Mayor, Council, you and your staff to the opening ceremonies and ribbon cutting for Westpointe Park. The event will be held at 4 p.m. on Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Westpointe Park is located at 3575 Stantonsburg Road and is now Greenville's westernmost — as well as its newest — park. It is presently accessible from Gretna Drive.

To access the park: Travel west past Allen Road on Stantonsburg Road, and follow it as it jogs left at the light (Walmart Neighborhood Market and Speedway Gas Station). Turn left on the second Westpointe Drive. Take the first right onto Ramsey Drive then the first right onto Gretna Drive. Pull into the gravel lot at the end of Gretna.

Phase I of the new park includes a playground with areas for ages 2-5 and 5-12, a walking path, open space play area and restrooms. Future development at the site is anticipated to include a picnic shelter, community building, multi-purpose fields and recreation courts.

We look forward to celebrating this special day with park neighbors, elected officials, and city staff.
