Presentation of the Stormwater Advisory Committee's (SWAC) Final Report to include the Stormwater Utility Rate Study

Explanation:

Abstract: The goal of the Stormwater Advisory Committee is to develop a vision for the future regarding stormwater management in Greenville through the review of development requirements and maintenance/operation practices. Specifically, the Stormwater Advisory Committee has considered changes to the extent and level of service, capital project implementation, and impacts to utility rate. The Committee, staff, and consultant will provide their recommendations for a sustainable Stormwater Management Program.

Explanation: The Stormwater Advisory Committee (SWAC) has met 14 times over the last year and a half to review the stormwater capital projects previously prioritized within the Watershed Master Plan. In conjunction with the review of capital projects, the Committee has considered changes to the extent and level of service and impacts to utility rate. Their recommendations for a sustainable Stormwater Management Program will be presented.

Fiscal Note: No fiscal impacts.

Recommendation: City Council consider the information provided in preparation for the upcoming

budget.
