Applicant: Designco Inc.

Project: Replace exterior door at detached garage

Mr. Cunningham delineated that property located in the College View District, the detached garage has an exterior door that has experience extensive rot and requires replacement. The existing door is a hollow core door typically used as an interior door. Under the stipulations in Chapter 2 pages 35-36 of the Design Guidelines Mr. Cunningham shared the parameters in which the repairs would be made. The proposed property has had two prior COAs in 1996 and 2016 and the Design Review Committee met on June 6 to discuss the request. Approval was recommended.

Mr. Moore shared that he wasn't quite sure what the composite wood consist of but that the door was an exterior door for this repair.
