

Dear Ms. Wall:

I am writing to personally thank you for the time and energy you invested in supporting East Carolina University and our legislative priorities during the 2021 session. I know everyone is quite busy, especially with full calendars and countless responsibilities, and I'm most grateful for your support as we worked to advance our goals.

The Greenville-Pitt County area serves as a hub for economic development, first class health care, and innovation. East Carolina University is proud to be part of such an incredible community. In my first nine months as Chancellor, I have witnessed a significant amount of resiliency in our region. 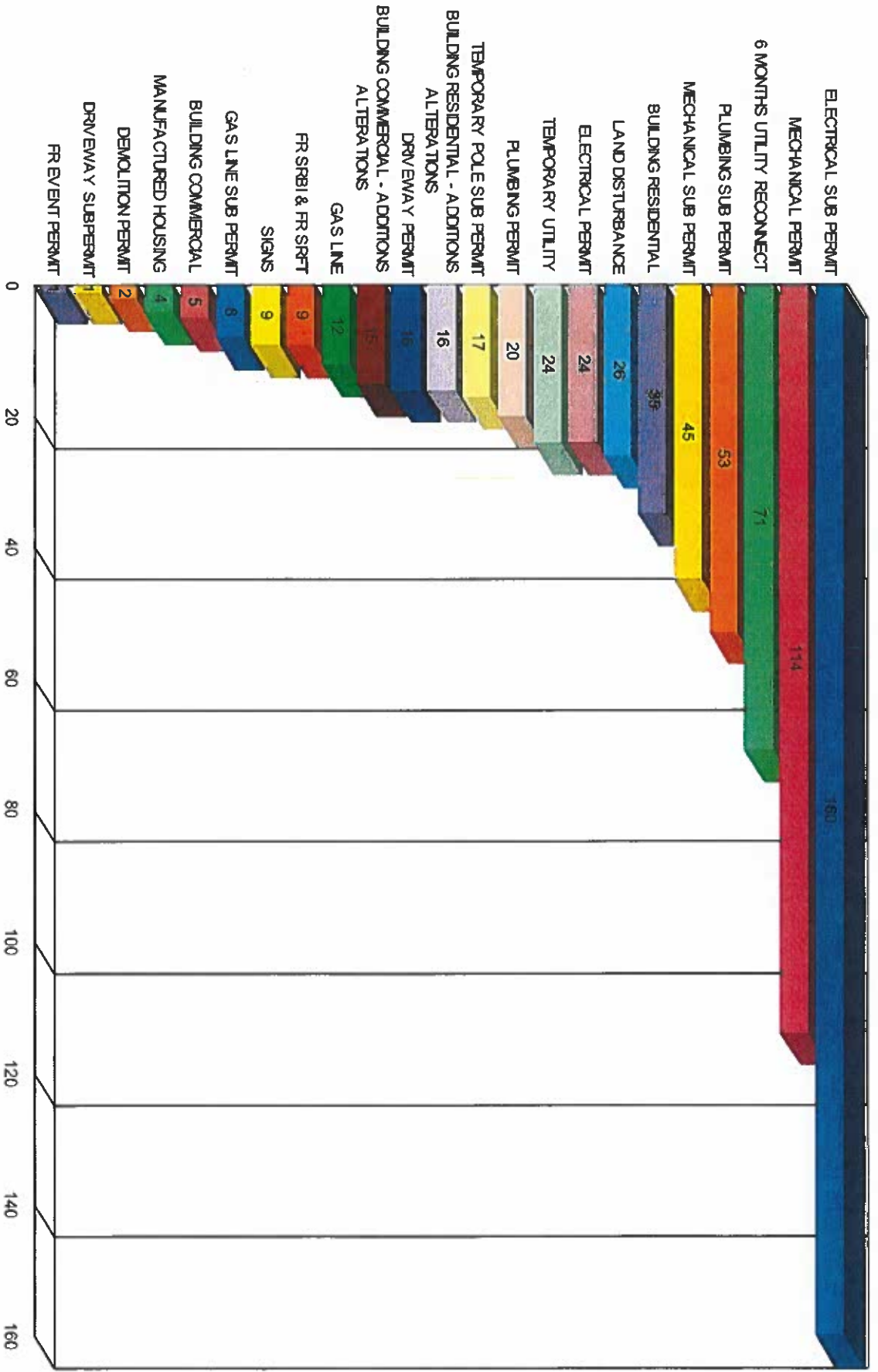
