Please let this serve as the Annual Report for the Greenville Firefighter's Relief Fund Board.

Our current board members are as follows:

- Mr. William Franklin- Treasurer (appointed by City Council)
- Mr. Eric Mullett- Member (appointed by City Council)
- Mr. Aaron Reeves- Member (appointed by Fire/Rescue members)
- Mr. Christopher May- Member (appointed by Fire/Rescue members)
- Mr. Brock Davenport- Chairperson (appointed by NC Commissioner of Insurance)

The NC Firefighter's Relief Fund was established in 1907 to financially assist firefighters that may have been injured while performing their duties, and to ensure that no firefighter would become financially destitute through no fault of their own. Over the course of many years the Firefighter's Relief Fund has seen several legislative revisions to permit the funds to provide additional services to include scholarships for member's dependents, Line of Duty Death benefits, as well as Accidental Death and Dismemberment insurance for members.

Some highlights of what our fund was able to provide for members this past year are as follows:

- Provided for seven scholarships to members' dependent children
- Submitted payments for member benefits
- Provided pension fund supplements for retired members
- Assisted an active duty member going through cancer treatments

We are extremely proud to be able to provide these services to our active members as well as our retired members, and will continue to collectively ensure that our fund remains fiducially sound for current and future members of the Greenville Firefighter's Relief Fund. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank the Mayor and each City Council member for their continued support of our board.

The Police Community Relations Committee (PCRC) was established to:

Serve as a liaison between the community and police over issues of common interest; to serve as an advocate for programs, ideas, and methods to improve relations between the community and the police; to disseminate information to the community and the City with regard to the state of relations between the community and the Greenville Police Department; and to assist and promote the community education efforts concerning safety awareness and community and individual awareness.

The PCRC meets monthly, with the exception of July and August. It has seven (7) members appointed by City Council. The Chief of Police serves as the Staff Liaison and the Assistant City Attorney provides the legal oversight and counsel. Mrs. Carol Naipaul serves as the current Committee Chair. To date, there is one (1) vacancy - District 1.

Despite the challenges associated with COVID-19, the Committee has continued to hold regular meetings. A brief summary of recent meetings is listed below.

Community Outreach/Engagement Report - Highlights for July 2022

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We ushered in July by celebrating National Freezer Pop day at all three of our substations on July 8, 2022. Community members were invited to cool down with a freezer pop and to share conversations with officers.







Cops and Barbers - July 5, 2022 - Our Cops and Barbers participants took the opportunity to say a final farewell to Chief Holtzman at Mission BBQ. Chief Holtzman has championed this initiative since its inception in 2016. It is based on the concept that barbershops are places where honest conversations about issues affecting the community take place routinely. They are places where police officers and citizens can meet, and through candid dialogue, form stronger relationships and cultivate enduring trust.

The evening was full of stories, laughter and reminiscing. One of their favorite stories was about a young boy who refused to go to school without a haircut. Eric Barnes, owner of Young Vision Barbershop, was called and



he and a police officer went to his shop on his day off and gave the young boy a haircut. After some lively conversation and some sound advice, the boy went to school, looking smarter and perhaps a little wiser.

The Cops and Barbers initiative has evolved over the years and become much more action oriented. There has been an expansion of outreach activities to include the distribution of back to school backpacks, holiday turkeys and Christmas toys. We are looking forward to enhancing this partnership and helping to further bridge the gap between police and the communities served.

Law Enforcement Agency of the Year – July 27, 2022 – The North Carolina Police Executives Association named the Greenville Police Department (GPD) as the Law Enforcement Agency of the Year. GPD received this recognition for being the first agency in eastern North Carolina to implement the Mobile Crisis Co-Responder Program.

GPD collaborated with Integrated Family Services to help improve the response to mental health-related calls such as suicidal attempts, mental illness and drug overdoses. The partnership responded to 800 calls last year.

Chief Holtzman, Deputy Chief Sauls and Captain Thomas were in attendance to accept the award.

Recruitment at Fort Bragg – The recruitment team was on the road again visiting Fort Bragg.

This time, the team included two GPD Army veterans who had the opportunity to interact with military personnel. This was a great time to share the benefits of joining GPD and help exiting soldiers with some of the barriers and challenges they may face as they transition to civilian status.




Other Highlights


