E. New Business

1. Agreement Extension

a. Habitat for Humanity of Pitt County

Ms. Johnson gave an overview of their agreement that began on August 17, 2021 and expires on August 16, 2022. They are requesting to extend their agreement until November 16, 2022. Ms. Johnson informed the committee that staff do allow up to a three (3) month extension. Their purpose is to construct a new home in the 45 Block Revitalization area for a low-moderate income person and/or family. They were awarded \$32,500.

Ms. Johnson read a letter to the committee from the Executive Director Scott Johnson from Habitat for Humanity of Pitt County that states: The 2021-2022 has continued to be challenging with rising costs and labor shortages in the construction industry. In order to maximize resources and funding opportunities, the house on 601 Vanderbuilt Lane has been delayed and permits are applied for and major components have been contracted. Therefore, the home should start to come out of the ground in the next thirty (30) days.

Ms. Jones asked if Habitat for Humanity of Pitt County do not expend the funds within 90 days, will they have to come back to the committee and request another extension.

Ms. Johnson stated that some of the line items are for preconstruction. Therefore, they would be able to expend those funds within the next 30-45 days.

Staff recommends the approval of this requests from Habitat for Humanity of Pitt County to extend their CDBG 2021 Public Service grant by three months (November 16, 2022).

Motion was made by Mr. Brock and seconded by Mr. Howard to approve staff recommendation. Motion carried unanimously.

F. Staff Report

a. Mandatory Non-Profit Funding Workshop

Ms. Johnson informed the committee about the Mandatory Non-Profit Funding Workshop that is designed to advise and assist non-profit organizations with meeting US Housing and Urban Development guidelines.
