Description: Greenie League Baseball involves instruction and competitive play for boys and girls. Games will take place weekday evenings and Saturday's. Players will need to attend a skills assessment, as a draft will determine team placement.

Location: Evans Park, Boyd Lee Park and other sites as needed.

Ages: 7–8

Days, Times, Dates: There will be two skill assessments for ages 7–8. Players only need to attend one assessment. The first skills assessment will be Monday, April 7 at H. Boyd Lee Park.
