What is it?

The Greenville Citizens' Academy is a six-week course in your local government. Each session will be an opportunity for participants to meet staff from different City departments and learn what they do. Expect to watch presentations, take tours, and participate in exercises which will give you a better understanding and appreciation of the inner-workings of your City government.

When is it?

Classes begin March 28, 2017, and are held for the next seven consecutive Tuesday evenings beginning at 6 p.m. with the exception of one Saturday (April 22, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.). Expect each class to last between two and three hours. Light meals will be provided.

Where is it?

The first class will begin in City Hall. Subsequent classes will take place at various City facilities.

Is there a cost involved?

No. There is no fee for participation, and participants will receive some materials and a light meal. The biggest cost will be your time.

Who will be involved?

Class size will be limited to no more than 25 students to allow maximum interaction, discussion, and hands-on activities. Participants will be selected to obtain a mix that will represent a crosssection of Greenville by geographic area (council district).

Citizens who are selected to participate will be notified by the Public Information Office and are strongly encouraged to attend all sessions to receive the full benefit of the program. If you are unable to make this commitment, please allow someone who can fully participate complete the application.
