5) Old Business

A. Symposium Award Discussion

The board discussed awards to be given for the 2015 Symposium and distribution of knowledge to the general public about the awards. NAB awards were distributed to everyone for them to share with neighbors, colleagues and friends. The committee working jointly with City staff will begin to distribute award criteria, and nomination forms. The awards for nomination are; (1) Good Neighbor Award (2) Neighborhood Excellence Award (3) Neighborhood Safety Award, and (4) Neighborhood Improvement Award. A onetime award called "Neighborhood Landlord" award for 2015.

B. Handbook Update

The handbook was reviewed by the NAB and Alternate Members at two special call meetings. The first meeting was held December 16, 2014 and the second meeting was held January 6, 2015. Both members and alternate members provided their suggested changes with additions and deletions to the handbook. Staff will submit changes to Merrill Flood, Director of Community Development for his review and approval. Discussions in the section not completed are listed below.

- Neighborhood Improvement / Beautification Award – Change the award to read "The Neighborhood Improvement Award". Delete the word "beautification" from the title of this award. The CAC (Community Appearance Committee) provides a similar award called the Beautification Award. There were concerns that the two awards would be a replica.
- Changes to the "**Selection Committee Members**" section -
Delete the verbiage as indicated below.
 - "The Selection committee members are chosen each year by the entities they represent:"Add a new verbiage to read as indicated below:
 - "The Liaison Ombudsman or the appropriate staff would convene the selection committee. The committee will consist of three of the representatives of the entities listed below."

C. District One Meeting

District #1 residents will host the Neighborhood Advisory Board (NAB) meeting on Thursday, February 19, 2015 @ 6:00 pm in Greenfield Terrace subdivision at the Barnes-Ebron-Taft Community Center, 401 Greenfield Blvd., Greenville, NC. City staff will be there to address neighborhood concerns in that district, to increase participation in their community, and plan for future development. The current flyer for distribution does not list the topic of interests. Topic of interest needs to be included on the flyer.
